Start of Ramadan	May 27	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Males (intact or castrated) and females under 12 months old</li> <li>Overly fat kids not desired</li> <li>Optimal weight: 60lbs (27kg), 45-120lb (20-54kg) accepted</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kid and buck prices spike beginning one month before holiday date</li> <li>Prices do not reach Easter premium</li> </ul>
Eid ul-Fitr (Feast of the Breaking of the Fast)	June 25	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Same as for the Start of Ramadan</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prices stabilize after Eid ul-Fitr</li> </ul>

Dussehra /Dassai	September 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Females are not acceptable</li> <li>Tenderness is important</li> <li>Weights depend on individual buyer</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stable prices</li> </ul>
Hanukkah	December 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Milk-fed kids</li> <li>Kosher processing desired</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prices increase during this time of year</li> </ul>
Christmas	December 25	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>High demand for all goat meat</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Prices peak right before holiday</li> </ul>
